MAIN POINT: Jesus Is Powerful

BIBLE VERSE:

"Great is our Lord, and mighty in power." Psalm 147:5a

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

There was a man who had been born blind. One day, he met Jesus. Jesus spit in the dirt to make some mud. He put the mud on the man's eyes, and then told him to go wash it off. When the man washed off the mud, he could see! Jesus had healed his sight. Jesus is powerful!

DO IT → JESUS IS POWERFUL

Supplies:

- Face template (1 per child, see last pages)
- Googly eyes (2 per child, optional, these can be drawn on)
- Crayons
- Glue

Activity Instructions:

- Set out the picture of the man's face in front of your child. Ask them what is missing.
- Glue the googly eyes onto the picture, or draw some of your own.
- Allow your child to finish colouring the picture.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- 1. Jesus is powerful. He used His power to create the whole world. He used His power to help people. He used His power to die on the cross and come back to life. How did Jesus use His power in our story today? (He used His power to heal the blind man and then the man could see.)
- 2. Jesus only uses His power for good because Jesus knows what is best for us. Jesus is still powerful today! When we ask Him to use His power, He can! He will do whatever is best for us and whatever brings Him the most glory. He is such an amazing God. Let's celebrate His power by saying in our loud voices, JESUS IS POWERFUL! Let's say it again. JESUS IS POWERFUL! Let's clap and cheer for Jesus.

Dear Jesus, Thank You for being so powerful! We know that You always know what's best for us. We love You. In Your name, Amen.
