## **MAIN POINT:**

Jesus Chooses Us to Follow Him

### **BIBLE VERSE:**

"'Come follow me,' said Jesus." Matthew 4:19a

#### **BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:**

Jesus chose some fishermen to join Him "fishing for people." They left their nets and followed Jesus. Jesus wants us to follow Him and tell everyone about Him. Jesus chooses us to follow Him!

### DO IT → FISHY DOT PAINTING

#### **Supplies:**

- White dinner-sized paper plate
- Scissors
- Stapler
- Googly eye (1) (you can also make an eye out of paper or draw one on)
- Sparkly bingo dauber (paint and a cotton ball is another option)
- Glue stick
- Marker to write on the fish

#### **Activity Instructions:**

- Cut a "pizza slice" out of the paper plate to make the fish mouth. Use the cut out piece to staple to the plate as the tail.
- Have your child decorate the fish with bingo daubers or paint.
- Help your child glue the googly eye on, or make your own.
- Along the edge of the plate, write "Come follow me,' said Jesus." Matt 4:19

# **TALK ABOUT IT:**

- 1. Who made the fish in the sea? That's right, God did! Let's name as many kinds of fish and sea creatures that we can think of. (Goldfish, puffer fish, bass, tuna, whales, dolphins, octopus, seahorses etc). God made them all unique and different. They all have different jobs under the sea. Each one is important.
- 2. God wants to be friends with everyone. But not everyone knows Him. He wants us to tell people about Jesus. That's what it means to "fish for people." Who are some people we can tell about Jesus? (Grandparent, auntie, uncle, friend from preschool, a neighbourhood family. Be intentional about inviting them into your circle and invite them to join you at church!)

Dear Jesus, We are so thankful that You chose us to follow You. Please help us learn how to follow. We want to tell others about You. In Your name, Amen.
