

MAIN POINT:

God Is Worshipped

BIBLE VERSE:

"The Lord is ready to help all those who call out to Him." Psalm 145:18a

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

The Bible tells us lots of ways that we can worship God: with our voices, our prayers, and serving others. One day, Paul and Silas were put in jail. While they were in jail, they started to sing worship songs to God. Suddenly, an earthquake shook the doors of the prison open. The guard thought all of the prisoners had escaped, but Paul and Silas assured him that they were all still there. They told him about Jesus, and he chose to follow Jesus! God loves when we worship Him because it brings Him glory.

DO IT → WORSHIP MARACAS

Supplies:

- Fillable plastic egg (1 per child)
- Plastic spoons (2 per child)
- Small handful of popcorn kernels
- Washi tape (optional, any other tape will work)
- Stickers (optional)

Activity Instructions:

- Help your child place the kernels inside the plastic egg and tape the egg closed on the seam.
- Place the egg between the spoons and secure with tape.
- Tape the ends of the spoon handles together.
- Decorate with stickers if desired.
