

MAIN POINT:

Psalms – God is Worthy Fireside Chat This week we review all we learned in the God is Worthy series. God is Worthy of our honor and our worship because He is the creator of all things; He sees and knows us; and He saves us from our sin. God is Worthy of our Thanksgiving and we can grow in thanksgiving by remembering the truths about who God is; inviting God into each moment of our lives; and by showing our thankfulness by living the way He wants us to. God is Worthy of our Trust. He is a great protector and provider and He never fails. We can trust Him in all things. God is Worthy of our Confession and so we can be honest with God; confess our sin to God; and believe that God forgives. God is Worthy of our Anger. In our anger, we can remember that God is a protector for the innocent; we are to love our enemies and oppose God's enemies; and we are to pray in alignment with God's character.

FAMILY DISCUSSION:

1. **What questions do you have about the God is Worthy Series? What was confusing? What was something that surprised you/something new you learned?** (Listen and respond.)
2. **Listen to the song from Psalm 34 called "Taste and See" and read the lyrics found at the end of this guide. What words stand out to you and why?** <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=yOzf0VrDNGU>
3. **What is one thing you learned or appreciated in a new way about who God is as you learned that He is Worthy of our thanksgiving, trust, confession, and anger?**
4. **We learned a lot about who God is as we read through the Psalms. I am going to say some statements we heard in this series and I want you to pick which one stands out to you the most.** (When they pick the statement that stands out/means most to them, ask them to share why they chose it/why it stands out to them)
 - a. *God is the Creator of all things*
 - b. *He sees and knows us*
 - c. *He saves us from our sin*
 - d. *God is a great protector*
 - e. *He is a good provider*
 - f. *He doesn't fail*
5. **Last week we learned from Psalm 7 that we are to love our enemies. How has that been going? What has been a challenge for you?**
6. **What is one thing God said to you during this series? What are you going to do about it?**

FAMILY PRAYER:

Ask your child how you can pray for them.

- What is their biggest concern this week?
- Where do they see God working in their life?

Pray with and for your child.
