

LESSON DISCUSSION GUIDE GRADE 5&6

January 27 & 28, 2024 Weekend

MAIN POINT:

Psalms – God is Worthy God is worthy of our attention, praise and worship. He is our Creator who sees us and knows everything about us. Most importantly, God saves us from our sin. Sin separates us from God and we would have no way of reconnecting with Him except through the sacrifice of Jesus. Jesus died on the cross to take the punishment for our sins and brought us back into a relationship with God. He is worthy!

God is worthy of our thanksgiving. We can be grateful to God through everything we go through—good and bad. What a witness it is to others to be faithful and keep trusting in God no matter what is happening in our lives. When we do this, others will see that we live differently than how the world lives. We will also show God that we are full of thanksgiving to Him for trusting Him.

FAMILY DISCUSSION:

- 1. In this series, we learned how God is worthy of our Thanksgiving (Psalm 116) and 3 ways for us to grow thankfulness in our lives:
 - a. Remember the truths of who God is He cares for and sees us, He hears and delivers us.
 - b. Invite God into every moment of your life
 - c. Show thankfulness.

What practical things have you been doing to differently to grow Thanksgiving in your life?

2. What is one thing God has said to you so far in this series? What are you going to do about it?

FAMILY PRAYER:

Ask your child how you can pray for them.

- What is their biggest concern this week?
- Where do they see God working in their life?
- Pray together as a family, taking turns thanking God for each other and asking Him to fill you
 with a desire to know and grow in your relationship with Him, removing all obstacles to fully
 trusting and knowing God, the One who loves you dearly and is worthy of your praise.
- Pray this over them: May (name of child) not only listen to your Word, but do what it says. James
 1:22 Lord, I ask that You take Your Word and place it into the heart of my child. May they always
 know You and desire to obey Your Word. May they be sanctified, becoming more like Jesus every
 day.
