

LESSON DISCUSSION GUIDE GRADE 5&6

January 6 & 7, 2024 Weekend

MAIN POINT:

Psalms – God is Worthy Worthy means deserving, having worth or value. Psalm 33 shows us why God is worthy. God is worthy because He is the Creator. He spoke all things into creation and revealed Himself through His creation. Only God has power mighty enough to create the mountains, oceans or stars. God is also worthy because He sees and knows us. God didn't just create the world and us then walk away. He is a God that is with us and remains close to us. He watches over us and knows everything about us— our joys and our pain. Finally, God is worthy because He saves us. Not only did God create us, sees us and knows us, but He loves us. When we put our trust in God and ask forgiveness of sin, God is able to forgive us and save us from our sin. God is worthy of all praise and worship.

FAMILY DISCUSSION:

- 1. What would consider the most valuable toy you have had growing up? Do you still have it?
- 2. Think about the things in your life that are valuable to you. What have you given too much value? How might God be asking you to make some changes with those things?
- 3. Let's read Psalm 33:13-15 and Psalm 33:20-22 together.
 - What stands out to you in these passages?
 - How does it make you feel when you read these things? (I am known by God, He sees everything, He is always with us, He helps us, He is Holy, we can trust Him, He is our Hope. Maybe you feel deeply cared for, noticed, protected, safe, hopeful that God will take care of all your circumstances.)
- **4.** What situations have you gone through where it was hard to say, "God is worthy?" (When something happens that is hurtful. When we disagree with something God decides like our parents not getting a job or allowing someone we care about to get sick. However, God knows things we don't and always works everything out.)

FAMILY PRAYER:

Ask your child how you can pray for them.

- What is their biggest concern this week?
- Where do they see God working in their life?

Pray with and for your child.

- Pray that your children will know that is God worthy of all praise and worship. May they know His love for them and acknowledge Him as their Creator and Sustainer.
- Pray this over them: May (child's name)'s heart be full of Joy because of You, Lord. May he/she trust in You because You are holy. May your faithful love be with him/her and his/her hope be in You. (Based on Psalm 33:21-22.)
