

MAIN POINT:

Jesus Can Do Anything; He is God.

MEMORY VERSE:

*"The Son is the exact likeness of God, who can't be seen. The Son is first, and he is over all creation."
Colossians 1:15*

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

Jesus, His mother, and His friends attended a wedding in Cana in Galilee. During the wedding feast they ran out of wine. Jesus' mother told the servants to do whatever Jesus told them to. Jesus told them to fill six large jugs with water. When they dipped into the jug, the water had turned to wine. Jesus had performed His first miracle. Jesus Can Do Anything; He is God.

DO IT → WATER TO WINE CRAFT

Supplies:

- Wine jar template (1 per child, see last page)
- Blue and red cellophane (or children may colour the wheel for a similar effect)
- Pencil crayons, crayons or markers
- Brad fastener
- Scotch tape (if using cellophane)
- Scissors

Activity Instructions:

- Print and cut out the craft template and then cut the hole in the jug.
- Colour as desired.
- Place the blue cellophane over the hole in the jug from behind, securing with tape.
- Cover half the circle template with red cellophane. (You'll need to cut the cellophane away from the centre circle or the brad won't go through.) Secure with tape.
- Alternatively, colour one half of the circle blue and the other half red.
- Place the circle behind the opening on the jar so that when you turn it the blue "water" turns to red "wine."

The Point

This craft can remind you that Jesus can do anything, including turning water into wine.

TALK ABOUT IT:

Do this section with your child while they are assembling their craft.

1. **If you were hosting a party, what food would you want to make sure didn't run out?** Discuss answers.
2. **When we give situations that cause us worry, over to God, we give Him the burden to carry. All we need to do is follow what He says to do. Has anyone ever seen God do something amazing that you want to share?** Discuss answers.
3. **Sometimes it's easy to think that since Jesus can do anything, that we don't have to do anything. But we need to be close to God and know His voice so that if He wants US to do something in obedience, we will know He is speaking to us. He might be asking us to go talk to someone new, and that's how He gives us a friend. Or He may want us to ask someone for help, and that's how He provides for our needs. It also means that we can listen to the needs of others and responding when we're able. We can be part of the miracle for someone, where God does amazing things in their life. Doing that helps us grow our own faith. How can we listen to what God is telling us to do?** (Read your Bible, pray, talk with other Christians, go to church.)

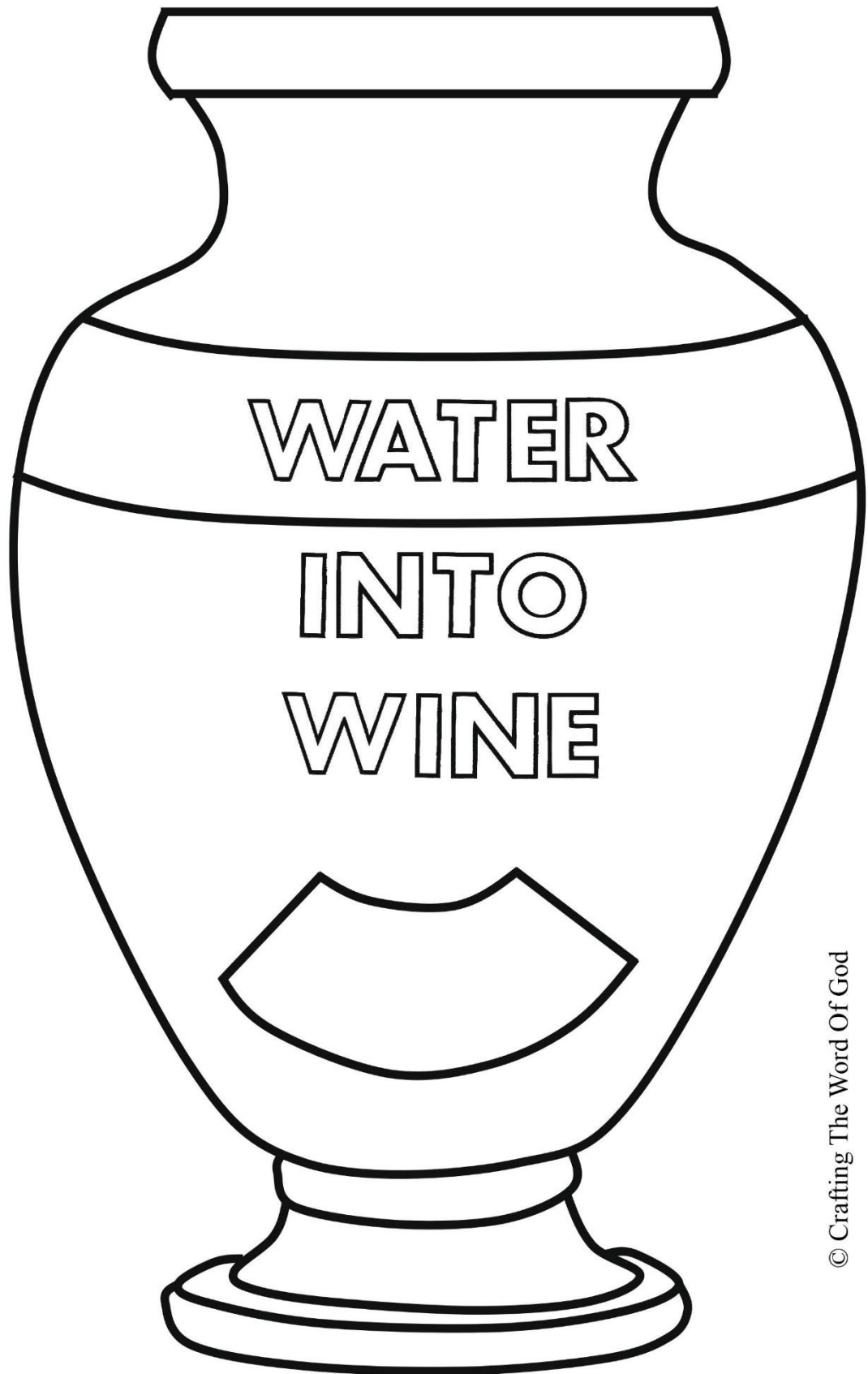
FAMILY PRAYER:

Dear God, thank You for giving us Jesus. We are so glad that Jesus can do anything! Please help us to believe in faith, and not worry. In Your name, Amen.

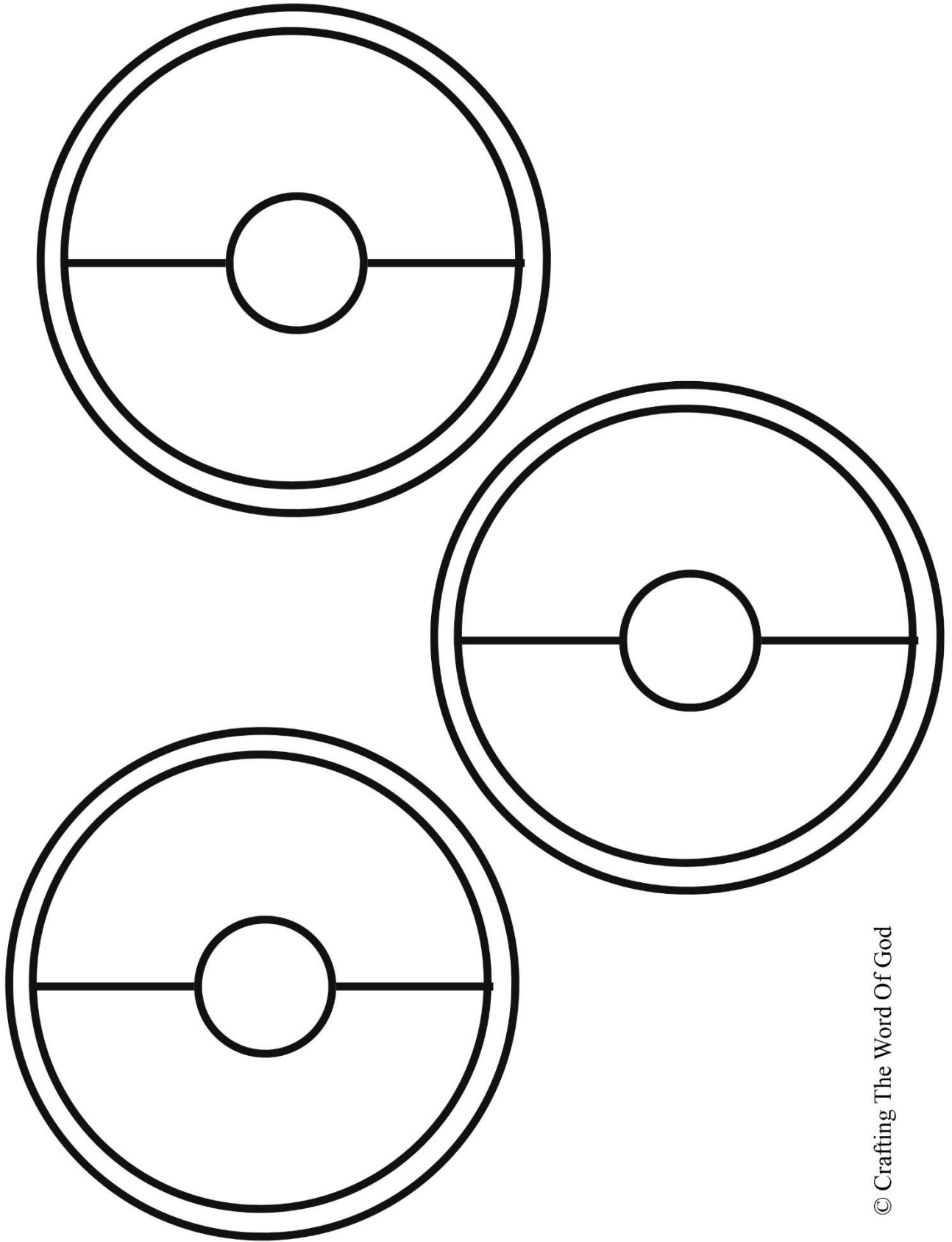
OFFERING:
