

SCRIPTURE MEMORY

Help kids learn and live God's Word.

How

- I. Know the child and his/her learning style.
- 2. Review, review, review.
- 3. Encourage kids to develop a routine.
- 4. Be creative by using games or other techniques for memorizing (see Awana Basics Sparks).

Why

- I. Learning and living God's Word honors Him
- 2. Memorizing Scripture guards against sinning
- 3. God's Word can be recalled when needed.

- Whole section in one sitting
- Two helps per section
- Recite reference and verse

Techniques for working with Sparkies

- Be clear! K-2nd graders take everything literally.
- Use hands-on media/games to draw kids in.
- **Talk** to **parents/guardians** about their child's spiritual interest.

HANDBOOK TIME •

- Pray.
- Listen to verses.
- Explain how each verse relates to Bible timeline.
- Keep records.
- Build relationships.
- Define and pronounce hard words.
- Use games to help kids memorize.

LARGE GROUP TIME

- Sit with Sparkies.
- Sing along with worship.
- Help Sparkies pay attention.
- Listen and learn along with Sparkies.
- Assist Sparkies in finding verses in the Bible.
- Cheer for your Sparkies during awards.
