


Journey Parent Guide

Journey establishes high school students as lifelong disciples through a deep study of God's Word, mobilizing them to live with godly perspective and evident faith. Journey is a three year high school ministry curriculum. The first three studies, Disciples with Josh Griffin, Advocates with Sean McDowell, and Witnesses. The Student Bible Study is a 32 week-long devotional that goes in depth on one topic each week. The study includes video lessons, questions, application activities, and other resources to help students dive into Scripture.



Advocates: considers what it means to for youth to hold firm to biblical convictions and still engage in humble dialogue with the culture around us. Sean McDowell, a leading apologetics and worldview author with this high school apologetics curriculum.

Disciples: discusses our Identity in Christ, being a disciple of Christ, rhythms of a Christian lifestyle and stewardship. The second half of the handbook discusses

Love, Suffering, the Church and Missions.

Witnesses: created to help you make disciples who make disciples. You will see excerpts and video lessons from lead evangelists, authors, and youth leaders such as Greg Stier, Harvey Carey, and Wes Stafford. These resources will provide you with what you need to train our students!

In small group time, students will work on sections all together with discussion and will recite verses they have memorized then will serve for the last hour of Awana.
